



A new work by choreographer and artist Anna Borràs Picó

Boreali culminates by creating a room where dance, immersive sound and interactive and digital media connects. Giving way to a full journey experience inside the dancing and crackling northern lights over the white winter landscape at the Swedish Lapland.

Inspired also by the yoik music and the eight seasons from the Sámi culture. Associating it into an internal personal period with the traditional korean music and the suwon soldiers.

A magical journey which will peak in a live dance performance alongside with moving image projections, lights and mapping by Jerry Salas together with synchronised 360 degree stereoscopic audio from Vincenzo Lamagna and Bora Ju.

Filled with physical dance, visuals and immersive sound making you be inside an Aurora Borealis. It lives and it captures these moments through the energetic and magical atmosphere created.

Northern Lights

Like an ebb and flow, the aurora borealis flows over us viewers and invites us to visually resonant emotions. A natural phenomenon that shines in unique shimmering color variations of pink, green and purple across the clear obscure night sky. A heavenly landscape is created when the northern lights fly, listen and dance like waves in the sky. When the electrically charged particles from the sun collide in the earth's atmosphere, chillingly peaceful, tumultuous and magnificent moments of beauty are created.

Artistic idea of Boreali

"Since I was a kid I have always been fascinated about the sky, space and its different magical constellations including phenomenons".

An exploration of the flying northern lights and its dancing sounds.

How to bring them into an intime place letting audiences see, hear, feel, and even touch them from very close by. A place where a full sensorial experience is on while enhanced by two performers on stage who will immerse us into this space and time.

Creating a scenic visualization of this phenomenon and to the general idea on being inside of an aurora borealis.

Inspired by the dancing and tinkling northern lights and its white landscape during winter. The ebb and flow of visual and aural emotions that moves people.

"The curiosity of these Aurora particles where thousand of them collides into the atmosphere. Transformed into solar rays, fire, into electricity. Charging electrical glimpses of that fire. I am fire particles." **The goal** of this production is to inspire all types of audiences. To provide tools and knowledge about this strange and spectacular phenomenon in the sky. To awaken hope for unreal beautiful moments and occasions which occurs to be different from what we expected.

We strive to create a sense of belonging, where dance/culture becomes a common experience that belongs to the whole community. To explore different audiences and locations and their impact on the performance. By introducing more culture and dance into their lives and enjoying and taking in all the valuable parts which helps us more than we think.

Boreali offers and integrates different perspectives of diversity and equality regardless of background, ethnicity or access. Everyone can get involved in the performance by walking through any moment, during the whole performance or being intermittent. The wish is to make everyone in the audience feel something different. By walking on the inner side of the northern lights, live their different colors, the physical dance and the magical sounds in their movements. So everyone gets access to enjoy the art. Our goal is to create a sense of belonging, where culture becomes a common experience that belongs to the whole community.

Biography and Approach

Anna Borràs is a Spanish born artist with base in Malmö, Sweden. She is

graduated in contemporary dance at the Institut del Teatre from Barcelona in 2010. Anna has worked beside different choreographers and companies such as Ramón Oller, Shlomi Bitton, Alexander Ekman, Akram Khan, Bebeto Cidra, IT Dansa, Verve12 (UK), Retina Dance Company, Jasmin Vardimon, Nicolas Ricchini Company, Jorge Crecis SQx, Companhia de Dança do Norte (Portugal), Simba Dance Ensemble (Norway), Kernel Dance Theater (Barcelona), Skånes Dansteater (Sweden), among others.

Anna has participated in several dance competitions the most remarkable could be: 1st solo prize at **II Certamen** Mujer Contemporanea (Almeria, Spain), 1st solo prize Premi Beca Roseta Mauri (Reus, Spain), awarded with a choreographic commission by T.H.E Second Company at the **M1 Contact Contemporary Festival in Singapore** (Asia), Avayava Contemporary Dance Festival, Pune (India), I Festival Internacional de Danza Contemporánea

Anna began her choreographic project Indra Dance Company in 2010 together with his colleague. When, after some years in 2014 she also started running own works and collaborations with international artists around the globe, institutions and youth companies under the sign of Anna Borràs Company.

Anna's movement vocabulary draws from intone dynamics, accurate energies and different physicality. Anna believe that the body and mind has always time and space to adapt and develop to a more defined and strong identity. How Anna moves can be defined as explosive, accented, fluid and honest.



At Anna Borràs's Company build kinesthetic skills and new perceptual awareness through **moving in contact** with others. That's why we create by playing long improvisation structures and contact tasks. This allows us to access different body - mind states which gives the chance to go above the physical boundaries and make everything limitless. Our mind has an underestimate power and it's a precious tool that makes everything you connect with your body become another path to research and **reach** virtuosity. Tuning both to the forces of gravity and momentum as to the beauty of the simplest gesture. We let go of excess tension to find ease and vitality. Our explorations bring subtlety, fullness, and flight to our dancing.

The choreographer aspiration is to understand human beings and their


personal relations as well as their relation to the surrounding world, never forgetting the comic side of things.

Throughout our dance we tell common stories, breaking the stereotypical hierarchy while creating an atmosphere where we initiate a simple journey in space and time which becomes a witness of balance between accessible and pioneer. We support the idea that art is an accessible medium of communication which can create a dynamic and at the same time fragile language that cannot be translated on another manner than dancing.

We also keep on exploring with the technology implemented in previous works.


We believe that "Dance is our urge to experience human nature and its multiple manifestations – strength and spirit.


